Reading PALS meets Mondays and Thursdays at Peace Dale Elementary School and is supported by twenty URI students and twelve community volunteers, most of whom are retired educators, administrators, and academic specialists. A total of eighteen third, fourth, and fifth graders participate in the research-based reading intervention program.
