3rd Graders Graduate, 1st Graders Join the Program

The Apple Seeds team has been hard at work creating an inviting and enriching after-school program. Fourteen 2nd and 3rd graders visited the Jonnycake Center two afternoons a week and engaged in academic, social-emotional, and collaborative learning opportunities this past fall. Our 3rd graders graduated in December and will now move on to PALS Reading Program at Peace Dale Elementary School. First graders joined Apple Seeds January 29th!



PALS Launches 3rd - 5th Grade at PDES

Reading PALS (Peer Assisted Learning Strategies) launched January 29th as a new program at Peace Dale Elementary School. Children work with reading partners to improve reading achievement and motivation. Seventeen URI students and just as many community volunteers will serve as mentors and tutors and be guided by Principal Rapport and Assistant Principal Hubertus. The program runs Mondays and Thursdays after school.



GEMS Launches

As part of our efforts to improve attendance, several administrators, staff, and teachers joined the Jonnycake Center team to offer middleschool girls a new reason to come to school: *Girls Empowerment, Mentoring, and Skills.* GEMS combines fun activities, such as cooking and jewelry-making, with practical skills and relationship-building to provide a safe space to

tap into their talents and make new friends.
